FACTS prove God's Word - 7

NIV at Acts 8:

36 They came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?" 38 Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.

FACTS prove God's Word - 8

The intent will be to provide a final and absolute authority, not to boost sagging sales or write a novel (called a paraphrase).

FACTS prove God's Word - 9

Since Jesus and Paul argued from individual words on at least nine occasions, it will exalt and protect each word ... it will despise the concept or publishing of paraphrases like The Living Bible or The Message.

FACTS prove God's Word - 10

Since Jesus and Paul argued from individual words on at least nine occasions, it will exalt and protect each word ... it will despise the concept or publishing of dynamic equivalent translations like the NIV.
